Tasks for volunteers

In advance of week:

Put together 2 first aid boxes

Buy biscuits/ squash / tea / coffee/ sugar / healthy snacks for Juniors

Buy milk each day during the event

Check St. Peter's and St. Laurence's weekly to make sure there are enough forms and top up if necessary

Put together arts and crafts for Messy Church

Regularly send out advertisements / reminders to schools and churches by email.

During the week:

Help transport items from storage or Life Church office to The Petersfield School on Sunday 30th July

Help transport items from The Petersfield School to Life Church office on Friday afternoon, 4 August.

Early help on Monday morning with registration, set-up and volunteers.

Clean up after each day and setting up for next day.

The main standard roles during the week:

Running registration desks for the whole morning in two locations.

Performing with the musicians.

Helping with arts & crafts for 0-8s.

Helping with 8-11s.

Serving tea/coffee.

Site security & troubleshooting.
