PACT Prayer is an initiative which encourages PACT churches to organise, host and steward a day of prayer, usually from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.

How each church organises their day, what theme - if any - that they employ and what materials they use is entirely up to those organising the day. This has resulted in widely differing styles of prayer but one that has been universally appreciated by all those involved.

During 2017 the following PACT Prayer Days took place, themes, if used, are noted:

- January: Life Church Petersfield – Petersfield and the Surrounding Area
- February: St Laurence – The Oppressed Church
- March: The United Reformed Church – The PACT Food Bank
- April: The Salvation Army – Prayer Walking Around Petersfield
- May: St Mary Magdalen, Sheet – The PACT Prayer Day was incorporated into the Week of Prayer
- July: St Mary's, Buriton – No theme but morning and evening prayer and the Eucharist were incorporated into the day
- August: Life Church – Praying for Our Nation
- September: All Saints', Steep – No theme, but Praying with Chocolate was included!
- October: The Salvation Army – Mission

Sadly, often due to illness, Prayer Days were not held every month. Prayer days for February and March 2018 are already planned.
